Project summary	<p>Bayer plc and Bradford Teaching Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust are working in partnership under a joint working agreement which aims to increase the capacity of the macular service through expansion and the creation of a second parallel patient pathway.</p> <p>The increased capacity in the macular clinic will aim to improve patient care by reducing the time to the first treatment and enable optimal follow up and retreatment of patients with retinal conditions</p>
